In Memoriam - Parenting an Individual with Disability - Lovingly, Hopefully

I write this as a tribute to a selfless, loving parent. Sandy lost her battle with cancer this past year. She was a mother of a 43-year-old son born with microcephaly, severe visual impairment, and intellectual disability. Throughout this unexpected journey, becoming a mother of a severely disabled child, Sandy's commitment was with a sense of wonder, delight in everyday experiences and hope that the world would be accepting and kind to her son. I became Sandy's executor and found myself reflecting on their lives. She demonstrated warmth, a quick wit and so much courage. I perceived her motherly pride throughout the years as evidenced with her thousand photographs! She was unapologetic for her son's appearance, awkward gait, gestures, and guttural sounds. Pending Voter Suppression Bills

The Brennan Center For Justice has a new article on pending and newly introduced voter suppression bills. As of January 2022, there are over 250 bills with restrictive voting provisions (in 27 states) that have been introduced, pre-filed or carried over from last year. Five Virginia bills would repeal state law that currently allows a person who requests assistance "by reason of a physical disability or an inability to read or write" to receive assistance with completing an in-person ballot or an in-person application to vote by mail. Washington has a proposed bill that would eliminate an existing state law requirement to provide access to individuals who are blind or visually impaired. https://www.brennancenter.org/our-work/research-reports/voting-laws-roundup-february-2022
