Important issues that will be addressed:

Part 1:

- Why an individual may need a legal guardian (decision making for school, community, health care, etc.)
- Responsibilities of the guardian and how the guardianship law protects an individual's rights.
- Overview of the guardianship process.

Part 2:

Hands-on walk through of the paperwork and process required to file for guardianship.

Take Wisconsin Avenue to 92nd St.


Turn North onto 92nd St.
